We meet you to make a plan together. You will have a support worker who can help with things like:



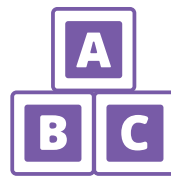

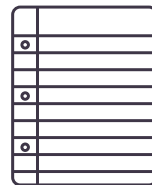
